

COVID-19 FAQ



We've pulled together some frequently asked questions to help you plan your trip to Saint-Pierre et Miquelon. Please read the information and consult all provided links to ensure you have the most up-to-date travel information.

Can I visit Saint-Pierre et Miquelon?

Fully vaccinated Canadian travelers are permitted to visit Saint-Pierre et Miquelon for any purpose. Non-vaccinated travelers may travel to Saint-Pierre et Miquelon for essential purposes only. For detailed information, visit the [Prefet de Saint-Pierre et Miquelon website](#).

How do I get to Saint-Pierre et Miquelon?

SPM Ferries operates a ferry service between Fortune, NL and Saint-Pierre et Miquelon. Ferries run Fridays, Sundays, and Wednesdays. Visit the [SPM Ferries website](#) to view schedules and book tickets.

Do I need a COVID test to enter Saint-Pierre et Miquelon?

Fully vaccinated travelers must provide proof of a negative COVID-19 PCR test taken within 72 hours before arrival to the territory OR proof of a negative COVID-19 antigen test analysed by an accredited lab taken within 48 hours before arrival to the territory.

Do I need to isolate upon arrival in Saint-Pierre et Miquelon?

Fully vaccinated travelers who have provided proof of a negative COVID-19 pre-arrival test are not required to isolate when they arrive in Saint-Pierre et Miquelon.

What documents do I need to bring with me to enter SPM?

Upon arrival in Saint-Pierre et Miquelon, you will need to present:

- A valid passport or valid government photo ID (click [here](#) for more information about acceptable forms of identification)
- Certificate of vaccination
- Proof of negative PCR test taken within 72 hours prior to arrival OR proof of negative antigen test analysed by an accredited lab taken within 48 hours prior to arrival
- Arrival forms (will be provided to you on board the ferry)

Do I need a COVID test to return to Canada?

To return to Canada, fully vaccinated travelers will need to provide proof of a negative COVID-19 PCR test, taken within 72 hours prior to arrival at the border. For more information, visit the [Government of Canada COVID-19 website](#).

Where can I get tested in Saint-Pierre et Miquelon?

To book your PCR test in SPM for return to Canada, contact the Coville Testing Centre: coville@secuspm.com. The cost for a PCR test is around 57 euros per person. **IMPORTANT:** Contact the Coville Testing Centre as soon as you know your travel dates to ensure you secure an appointment in time to return to Canada.

What do I need to do for my return to Canada?

Travelers returning to Canada must provide:

- Proof of vaccination
- Proof of a negative PCR test taken within 72 hours prior to arrival
- Reference number from completed [Newfoundland and Labrador travel form](#), if arriving in Newfoundland
- Receipt from completed [ArriveCan](#) submission
